Best Practices

Best Practice I: Student Counselling Centre

The College has a Student Counselling Centre, comprising mainly of the faculty members of Psychology, which is actively engaged in motivating the students to become decisive and confident enough to survive in this perilous society, as being a girl child some students have unsafe atmosphere at home as well as outside. It also enables the students to have a stress-free learning. The centre is also taking initiatives to make the students aware of the ill-effects of social media. The centre also extends its services to the nearby areas through outreach programmes especially in the government schools.
